

## 2008-09 Attendance Area Change

### Open Enrollment for Students Not Affected by Grandfathering Provisions



Children not affected by grandfathering provisions made by the LASD Board of Trustees wishing to attend an LASD school other than their school of residence for the 2008-09 school year should fill out an Open Enrollment Request form at the District Office and return it to the LASD District Office by January 31, 2008.

An open enrollment waiting list for each grade level at each school will be established by the Superintendent. Students will be placed on the waiting list in the following prioritized order:

1. (For Fall 2008 only) First priority will be given to students being reassigned due to 2008-09 attendance area changes, and currently attending their requested school under one of the following conditions:
  - a. a resident under the 2007-08 attendance areas,
  - b. a 2007-08 open enrollment student, or
  - c. a student overflowed from their 2007-08 school of residence.*Within this group, priority will be determined by number of years a student has attended the requested school. Ties will be broken by a blind, random drawing by the Superintendent's Office.*
2. Students who are applying for open enrollment for the first time, including kindergartners.  
*Within this group, for all applications received by January 31, 2008, order of placement will be determined by lottery.*
3. Any students whose applications are received after January 31, 2008, will not be given priority placement on the waiting list. Applications submitted after the deadline will be placed on the waiting list in the order received.

By April 30, 2008, the number of spaces available within each grade level at each school will be determined by the Superintendent after all resident students have been placed. The District shall have the right to reserve spaces for new resident students expected to enroll after April 30, 2008, based on that school's enrollment history.

Open Enrollment status will be approved on an annual basis. A student's Open Enrollment acceptance at a school in no way guarantees continuation of that approval in subsequent school years.
